- (1) Mark the oval above the name of your choice.
- (2) To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, print the name clearly in the box labeled “Write-in,” staying within the box.

- (4) To vote on a question or proposal, mark the oval below your choice.
- (5) You have a right to a replacement ballot. If you make a mistake or want to change your vote, call the Board of Elections at 607-687-8261 for instructions on how to obtain a new ballot.
- (6) The number of choices is listed for each contest. Do not mark the ballot for more candidates than allowed. If you do, your vote in that contest will not count.
- (7) After completing your ballot, insert it into the OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE provided, seal and sign.
- (8) Return your ballot to the Tioga County Board of Elections by following the instructions printed on the OFFICIAL BALLOT ENVELOPE.
